

# Are you a recent migrant from India? Are you currently pregnant or recently had a baby?

*Indian Migrant Women's Expectations and Experiences of Maternity Care*

## What is the study about?

Current research suggests that migrant women's expectations of maternity care are unique, and go beyond just the clinical management of pregnancy. Studies also indicate that women's expectations and experiences of care may be shaped by their social and migrant situations. This study aims to investigate how maternity care services in Melbourne respond to the expectations of Indian migrant women, based on their experience with these services.

## You may be eligible if you:

- Migrated to Melbourne, Australia from India after 2011
- Are currently pregnant or gave birth after 2019

## What will it involve?

- One to two in-person (or phone) interviews with a researcher (about 60 minutes each)
- Interviews will be conducted in English, at a convenient location.
